KIDS CLUB DETAILS

Emergency Care

If an emergency situation occurs with your child, we will make every effort to contact you. We will also contact the First Aid Patrol on the mountain. If for any reason you do not wish to have us contact any medical personnel, please notify us when you drop off your child.

Medications

We require that a parent administers all medications. Please talk to an attendant about special needs, (inhalers, etc.). For approved special needs, medication must be in its original container with the child's name, the dosage required and the name of the doctor. The parent or legal guardian must fill out a medical consent form.

Discipline

If there is a rare behavioral problem we will use a "time out." It will generally equal one minute per one year of age.

Cancellation Policy

Notice of cancellation must be given 24 hours prior to registered date. If a child does not attend on any registered date without proper notification, a charge of \$25 will apply.

Exclusions/Illnesses

The following are a few of the illnesses/symptoms that would exclude your child from Kids Club according to the State of Wyoming rules: diarrhea, vomiting, fever over 102, skin rashes (not diaper rash), untreated head lice or scabies. For a more complete list, please ask at Kids Club.

Naps

We provide places for children to nap. We try to accommodate the needs of all children, as their schedules require. Children not napping are provided with quiet activities such as stories, age appropriate movies, or arts and crafts.

Hours of Operation

Our hours of operation are 8:30am-4:30pm. Half day hours are 8:30am-12:30pm, or 12:30pm-4:30pm. Please pick your child up promptly by 12:30pm or 4:30pm accordingly. **An additional fee of \$1.00 per minute will apply for late pickups.**

Payment

Payment is expected daily. We accept cash, checks, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover cards. If you are staying at Grand Targhee, you may charge your childcare to your room, provided the front desk has a credit card on file.

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What to Bring

- Change of clothing
- Snow pants
- Jacket
- Mittens
- Ski hat
- Snow boots
- Indoor shoes or slippers
- Sunscreen and Sunglasses (to protect against ultra-violet rays)

In addition Infants will need diapers, wipes, baby food and formula

Ski Gear

- *Remember to rent equipment prior to coming to Kids Club*
- Metal edged skis with release bindings
- Buckle ski boots
- Helmet
- Goggles
- Socks (We recommend non-cotton such as wool or polypropylene)
- Long underwear
- Ski jacket & ski pants or snowsuit

Please remember to label all of your child's belongings

Release Forms

Please arrive early in order to complete paperwork. We must have medical information / release forms signed by a parent or legal guardian in order for your child to participate in activities.

Payment

Payment must be received in full at check-in.

Lunch / Snacks

Lunch and snacks are provided by Kids Club

Safety

Be assured that Kids Club staff has First Aid and CPR training and will do the most to provide a safe, comfortable experience for the children. While accidents are infrequent, in the event of an injury we have emergency procedures in place. We also provide Firefly phones in order to maintain communication with parents.
