SKIER LEVELS

- LEVEL 1** First time on skis *or* can stand and slide
Can not stop
- LEVEL 2 :** Can stop. Learning to turn. Possible
chair lift rider
- LEVEL 3 :** Solid wedge turner
Comfortable green terrain skier, matching in traverses
- LEVEL 4 :** Skies in wedge-christie. Introduction to blue
terrain, Introduction to parallel skiing
- LEVEL 5 :** Skis full parallel on green terrain
Practicing parallel on blue terrain
Introduction to ungroomed snow
- LEVEL 6 :** Improving parallel on blue terrain
Explores ungroomed snow, beginning to plow plant
Learning to ski blue bumps
- LEVEL 7 :** Refining parallel turns on steeper blue and some black
- LEVEL 8 :** Parallel turns on *all* blue and *most* black runs
Skis good bump line, skis off trail (powder/crud)
- LEVEL 9:** Dynamic parallel turns on steep terrain, bumps, powder
All mountain skier!

SNOWBOARDING LEVELS

- LEVEL 1:** First time on a snowboard.
- LEVEL 2:** Able to use lift and get down
beginner slopes, usually on
one edge only.
- LEVEL 3:** Able to make turns on green slopes.
Rider can go from toe edge to
heel edge without stopping
- LEVEL 4:** Comfortable riding blue terrain.
- LEVEL 5:** Comfortable riding black terrain
- LEVEL 6:** Able to handle anything
Bumps, freestyle, powder
