Participants (12 & older) are to meet by 4:45 p.m. at the Ski and Snowboard School for registration. Roadside flares are used in the adult parades so participants are encouraged to wear clothing appropriate for handling these torches. There's also a special Children's "Glowstick Parade" on the beginner terrain on both occasions. Children 12 & younger can register before 4:15 p.m. at the Ski & Snowboard School and be prepared to load the Shoshone lift at 4:30 p.m. sharp (minimum age for children's participation is 5). A special fireworks display will immediately follow the Torchlight Parade on New Year's Eve with complimentary refreshments available on the plaza.

On Saturday, December 30th "Melefluent" will be performing in the Trap Bar from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and on New Year's Eve from 10:00 p.m. into the New Year and there is no cover charge for this special holiday entertainment. A complimentary resort shuttle will depart Driggs for Grand Targhee at 8:00 p.m. (pickup at 1st Street & Ski Hill Road) with return trips scheduled to leave Grand Targhee at 1:00 a.m. and 2:30 a.m. "This holiday season we're looking forward to sharing in a festive reunion with our returning lodging guests and day visitors," stated Susie Barnett-Bushong, resort spokesperson.

Guests car pooling to Grand Targhee this entire winter season will enjoy premium parking for their effort.
