



2026 Grand Targhee Resort Event Code of Conduct

We are grateful for the opportunity to host you here at Grand Targhee Resort for this exciting event. Each visiting organization and/or participating individuals must hold themselves, their athletes, parents, officials, and coaches accountable to their own codes of conduct as well as Grand Targhee Resort Code of Conduct while on Grand Targhee Resort property.

- Treat everyone at Grand Targhee with Dignity and Respect.
- Organizations, Athletes, Parents, Officials and event guests must follow Grand Targhee rules and obey all signs and closures.
- All parties must respect Grand Targhee posted quiet hours.
- Horseplay and disturbing other GTR guests and employees will not be tolerated.
- Public Intoxication will not be tolerated at event venues. Consumption of outside alcohol is not permitted at on-mountain event venues.
- Parents will be held accountable for the behavior of their child while on property for the event. If parents are not accompanying the child at the event, team head coach will be held accountable.
- All parties must abide by the following **Targhee Responsibility Code** while at Grand Targhee
 1. Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
 2. People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
 3. Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
 4. Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
 5. You must prevent runaway equipment
 6. Read and obey all signs, warnings and hazard markers.
 7. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
 8. You must know how to be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
 9. Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
 10. If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.
- Failure to follow your own organizational Code of Conduct, Grand Targhee Rules & Code of Conduct, Grand Targhee Signs, and Closures may result in consequences up to and including banning athletes, parents, coaches, and officials from Grand Targhee, disqualification from the event and or cancelation of the event.
- Mistreatment, abuse, threats or harassment by any party associated with the event will not be tolerated and may result in consequences up to and including banning athletes, parents, coaches, and officials from Grand Targhee, disqualification from the event and or cancelation of the event, as well as potential law enforcement engagement.
